Test Drives Now Allowed; Curbside Delivery Can Begin on Monday, May 25

After extensive lobbying by your Association team, the Baker-Polito administration late on Sunday, May 24, amended the rules for dealership sales operations to **allow for test drives**. This change removes the previous prohibition on test drives first imposed by the administration on May 4. To quote from the new guidance under the FAQs, **“Test drives are permitted if the customer is the only person in the car. The vehicle and keys must be cleaned and sanitized after each test drive.”**
